Under Project Laadli, our Pratirodh Center in Amarpura, Rajasthan, has started Mehndi classes for 50+ girls. They're learning this traditional art to boost creativity and earn during weddings and festivals.

Building on our existing 5 centers, we aim to start new women - led tailoring units, helping women gain livelihood skills and become financially independent.

We will promote reading, imagination, and expression by establishing Pustak libraries across learning centers-making books a joyful part of every child's life.



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
